Our cats live in a network of volunteer foster homes throughout the GTA until they are adopted into suitable, loving homes; we do not have a shelter. We are not government funded and we have no paid staff; we rely exclusively on the generosity of like-minded animal lovers to fund our program.

Unlike most animal shelters, Abbey Cats has a zero-euthanasia policy. This means that no cat in our program is ever "put-down" due to old age, lack of space, or adoptability. Every Abbey Cat is guaranteed a safe, loving foster home, quality food and veterinary care until they are permanently placed with a carefully screened adopter.

Abbey Cats prides itself on the health of each and every cat adopted from our program. Since 2002, ACA has successfully placed more than 2000 cats and kittens, and has an additional 175 in foster care.
