A Rescue Story Still Waiting for a Happy Ending

We received a call from a shelter asking us to help 12 cats that were scheduled for euthanasia due to lack of space.

When we got to the shelter, the cats were all being housed together and since it was impossible to just pick a couple and leave the rest behind, we decided to take them all! We couldn't possibly leave some to die the next morning.

Since we didn't have anywhere to place these cats, one of our volunteers offered us the use of the back of her office on a VERY temporary basis until we could find foster and/or

permanent homes for the 12 cats.

At the moment there are two volunteers checking in on the cats but since this place is unoccupied and has been broken into twice before, we are afraid someone is going to break in and do something to these helpless creatures.

To make matters worse, the building will soon be closed down for the winter so we must get the cats a place to stay as soon as possible!

All of the cats seem to really enjoy the company of other cats; almost all of them are very social, kid-friendly and they are all spayed/neutered. They are also dewormed and

microchipped and eager to find a loving permanent home.

We URGENTLY need placement for these wonderful kitties and in order to expedite this rescue effort we are willing to halve the adoption fee.
